The 1985 Hopewell Cultural Resource Survey covered Hopewell Township, Hopewell Borough, and Pennington Borough. The survey included over 1000 sites up to 1875, with discussions of their history and architecture, and associated photographs.

Each individual site in the 1985 survey is identified by a Historic Sites Inventory Number, which begins with the municipal code (e.g., 1105 for Hopewell Borough), followed by the block and lot numbers, e.g., 1105-12-34. (Note the Hopewell Borough property block and lot numbers were changed in 1994-95 from the numbers used since the 1800's.)
